In re: John Davidson It is alleged that the analysis of human urine sample #723L provided by John Davidson at Bangor Raceway on June 27, 2006 disclosed the presence of Benzolecgonine, a cocaine metabolite. It is also alleged that this will be Mr. Davidson's third human urine positive test within the past ten years. CONTINUED FROM SEPTEMBER 26, 2006
