Switzer, Jr. – Mr. Switzer has appealed the preliminary denial of his application for a harness racing license for calendar year 2010 for the alleged violation Maine State Harness Racing Commission rule Chapter 17 Section 3, sub-section 2. Mr. Campbell is alleged to have violated Maine Harness Racing Commission rules accumulating fines in the amount of \$2,000.00 or more in the previous two racing year, 2008 and 2009.

IN RE: Pursuant to Title 8 MRSA Section 271 subsection 7: "Prior to August of each year, the commission shall conduct a hearing to determine whether the horse supply in the State has been adequate for the number of dashes conducted on assigned race dates. If the commission concludes that the horse supply has been inadequate, the commission shall limit to the extent necessary the number of dashes that a licensee may race on any date after August 1st of that year that has been assigned to more that one track. The commission may not restrict the number of dashes to fewer than ten."
